# 4. Section Four – Membership

- 4.1. Membership shall be open to any individual who is connected with the College in the following manner and will consist of the following classes:
  - i. Ordinary (Class I) Member: Any person who is a Graduate is eligible to become an Ordinary (Class I) Member upon:
    - (a) Payment of the prescribed subscription fee;
    - (b) Submission of documentary proof of graduation; and
    - (c) Submission of a membership application form.
  - Ordinary (Class II) Member: Any person who is or has been a student of the College regardless of whether he has graduated, is eligible to become an Ordinary (Class II) Member upon:
    - (a) Payment of the prescribed subscription fee;
    - (b) Submission of documentary proof that the applicant has ever been a Morningside student; and
    - (c) Submission of a membership application form.
  - iii. Student Member: Any person who is currently enrolled as a student of the College and has not graduated is eligible to become a Student Member upon:
    - (a) Submission of required documentary proof of student status; and
    - (b) Submission of a membership application form.
  - iv. Honorary Member: Any person who has made special contributions to the Association is eligible for election as an Honorary Member upon invitation by the MCAA committee after an internal vote. No subscription fee is required.
- 4.2. No Member is allowed to hold more than one membership in Ordinary Class I and Class II at the same time. Any Member eligible for an Honorary Membership can hold it in addition to, if any, another class of Membership.
- 4.3. Membership in all the above classes shall be for a lifetime, with the exception of Student Membership which will terminate upon the student becoming a Graduate.

- 4.4. Rights of Members:
  - i. Participate in any activities for the membership class organized by the Association; and
  - ii. Attend General Meetings and express opinions.
- 4.5. Rights of Ordinary Members:
  - i. Participate in the Election Committee.
- 4.6. Rights of Ordinary (Class I) Members:
  - i. Elect and to be elected as an Executive Committee member of the Association;
  - ii. Nominate and be nominated as an Executive Committee member of the Association;
  - iii. Propose resolutions and vote in the General Meeting;
  - iv. Propose amendments to the Constitution; and
  - v. Appoint a Proxy to attend a General Meeting.
- 4.7. Duties of Members:
  - i. Uphold the Constitution;
  - ii. Pay any fees as required for their class of Membership; and
  - iii. Support and promote the activities organized by the Association.
- 4.8. Additional duties of Ordinary (Class I) Members:
  - i. Attend and vote in General Meetings.
