[1] Student's portfolio other than academic attainment will be considered; the final decision of the granting of scholarships rests with the College and is dependent upon availability of funds. Not all scholarships are renewable. Recipients of renewable scholarships are required to achieve a GPA of 3.0 or above to be considered for scholarship renewal and are subject to all other relevant rules and policies related to renewable scholarships. Scholarship results will be announced to awardees in mid of Term 1.

[2] Students receiving a Full Scholarship (Full tuition plus allowance) from the University are eligible for a maximum renewable scholarship of HK\$14,000 from the College only.
